




MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Request by Reasons Construction Company for reduction of surety bond on P324-M-CO, consisting of 15.01 acres.

A field trip was conducted by the Mined Land Review Committee on March 10, 1983 for the purpose of evaluating the Phase I reclamation efforts of the operator, Reasons Construction Company.

On completion of the inspection, the Mined Land Review Committee was in agreement that the operator had satisfied all but one requirement as established in the Final Contour and Reclamation Map in the permit package. A small coal pile and topsoil pile still remains on the east side of the permit area. The operator indicated the coal would be removed and the topsoil spread by March 15, 1983. On that day Mr. Van Buren (P.C. & E.) will make an inspection to determine if the work is complete and satisfactory. Upon his approval of the additional work and on the basis of the operator having fulfilled the requirements, it is recommended by the Mined Land Review Committee that the operators request for Phase I be honored. The total reduction for Phase I will amount to \$18,754.00.

If the additional work is not satisfactorily completed as outlined above, the Committee does not recommend release at this time.



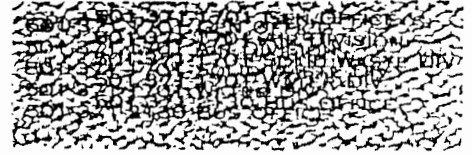
