SUMMARY OF 40 CFR Parts 144 & 145

APRIL 1, 1983

This rule reorganizes the presentation of permit program requirements governing the Hazardous Waste Management program under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the Underground Injection Control (UIC) program under the Safe Drinking Act (SDWA), the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) and the Dredge or Fill (404) programs under the Clean Water Act (CWA) and the prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program under the Clean Air Act. This rule makes no substantive changes to any of the affected sections. The Agency is simply physically deconsolidating its Consolidated Permit Regulations in response to the President's Task Force on Regulatory Relief which asked that the EPA review the Consolidated Permit Regulation. The intent is to make the regulations easier to understand and to use.
