

EMERSON COAL COMPANY

Emerson Coal Company, Permit #81, was taken over and reclaimed by Sugarloaf Mining as part of their permit No. 98, Excelsior Mine area.

A field trip was made May 1, 1984, for the purpose of positive affirmation that this Emerson Coal Company property is part of the now accepted and released Sugarloaf permit No. 98 area.

On the basis of this inspection by the Mined Land Review Committee members, it is recommended that Mr. Tom Emerson's surety posted (\$2,000) be approved for 100% release back to him.

B & M Mining Company - Fort Smith, Arkansas

On the basis that all boreholes have been back-filled, and no mining having occurred, B & M Mining Company has requested 100% reduction (\$5,000) on permit No. 0041-X-CO.

A field trip was made by the Mined Land Review Committee for inspection and evaluation of this operator's effort. On the basis of this inspection, it is recommended by the Mined Land Review Committee members that this operator's request be honored for full reduction of surety posted.

TRIARK Incorporated - Bates, Arkansas

Triark Incorporated has requested 100% reduction of surety posted on permit No. 197 on the basis of no intention to mine this 2-acre permit.

A field trip was made on May 1, 1984, for inspection and acceptance on approval. Following this inspection and conference, the Mined Land Review Committee members recommend that this operator's request for reduction of (\$2,000) surety posted be honored at this time.




On the basis of this inspection by the Mined Land Review Committee members, it is recommended that Mr. Tom Emerson's surety posted be approved for release back to him.

A field trip was made this date for inspection and acceptance. Following a complete inspection of this permit, it was determined that all boreholes had been back-filled and no mining had occurred.


On the basis of this inspection, it is recommended by the Mined Land Review Committee members that this operator's request be honored for full reduction of surety posted.


