

VESTA ENERGY - JOINT VENTURE

Vesta Energy - Joint Venture has requested 60% reduction (Phase I of the Mine Permit) on permit # P232-M-CO.

On June 12, 1984, the Mined Land Review Committee (MLRC) conducted an inspection on permit #P232-M-CO in order to evaluate the permittee's Phase I reclamation efforts. At the conclusion of the inspection, the MLRC members agreed that the Phase I efforts of the permittee were satisfactory and that a 60% reduction of the performance bond was in order. The total reduction for this phase will be \$18,111 Mining for Phase I of Phase I area only.

SEVEN C'S CONSTRUCTION COMPANY

Mr. Gary Cobb, operator of Seven C's Construction Company, permit #P313-M-CO, requests 60% reduction for Phase I of the Mine Permit on surety posted on this permit.

Following an inspection by the Mined Land Review Committee on July 3, 1984, it was determined by the committee members that this operator's efforts for new surface contour, respreading of topsoil, and approved revegetation plan with reseeding and mulching which is now complete is acceptable for Phase I reclamation requirements. The total reduction for this Phase I will be \$3,000.00

SEVEN C'S CONSTRUCTION COMPANY

Mr. Gary Cobb, owner of Seven C's Construction Company, permit #P334-M-CO, requests 60% reduction for Phase I of Mine Permit of surety posted.

Following an inspection by the Mined Land Review Committee on July 3, 1984, it was determined by the Committee Members that this operator's efforts are acceptable for this request as being in full compliance with Phase I reclamation of surety posted. The amount of reduction on this permit is \$6000 (Phase I only).



SUBJECT: Phase I reduction of performance on Vesta Energy - Joint Venture,
permit #P232-M-CO, (Phase I of Mine Permit).

In accordance with Section 807.12(e) of the Arkansas Surface Mining and Reclamation Code (Code), Phase I shall be deemed to have been completed when the permittee completes backfilling, topsoil replacement, regrading, and drainage control in accordance with the approved reclamation plan. As perscribed in Section 807.12(b)(1) of the Code, the permittee is entitled to 60% of the total applied performance bond when Phase I has been deemed completed.

On June 12, 1984, the MLRC conducted an inspection on permit #P232-M-CO in order to evaluate the permittee's Phase I reclamation efforts. At the conclusion of the inspection, the MLRC members agreed that the Phase I efforts of the permittee were satisfactory and that a 60% reduction of the performance bond was in order. The total reduction for this phase will be \$18,111 (Mining Phase I only).





be granted for 60% of surety reduction as posted.








It is recommended by the Mined Land Review Committee that this operator's request be granted for 60% reduction of surety posted on this permit.




