

Public comment has been received on the Draft FY'85 Construction Grants Priority System and List. Public comments included several subjects: 1) The funding of the second phase of the Fayetteville project; 2) The Priority System in general; 3) The population factor in the Priority System; 4) The need to include phased projects previously funded through the program along with segmented projects in the system; 5) The allocation of funds between the large community priority list, and the small community priority list.

In addition to the public comment received, one other factor has impacted the Draft FY'85 Priority List. Due to the unusually large amount of funds recovered during FY'84, the FY'84 Priority System dictates that additional projects be funded during that year. The additional projects now to be funded must be removed, therefore, from the Draft FY'85 Priority List. Also, two of the projects now shown on the Draft FY'85 Priority List must be segmented, and receive the segmented project points if the Draft FY'85 Priority System is maintained as presented to the public.

Based upon these comments and the supporting data, the Commission hereby approves the Draft FY'85 Priority System and Priority List with the following changes:

- 1) Item number 6 of the Large Entity Priority Ranking System of the Priority System will be revised to include phased projects along with segmented projects.
- 2) The Large Community Priority List will be revised to include the second segments of the Benton and Jacksonville projects on the fundable list, and result in Pleasant Hill S.I.D. moving to the non-fundable list. It is not anticipated that Pleasant Hill S.I.D. will be ready to proceed in FY'85.
- 3) The Small Community Priority List will be revised to remove the Melbourne and Hackett projects from the list, and to move the Hoxie project to the fundable portion of the list.
