

MINUTE ORDER NO. 84-69

SOLID WASTE SECTION
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The Commission hereby approves the permit application submitted by the following firm, subject to the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Act, the Solid Waste Management Code, and the permit terms and conditions.

United Sanitation - Jonesboro

United Sanitation Landfill #2

Additional Conditions: (1) This permit shall expire when the approximate 49.6 areas described in the final engineering plans has been filled to design capacity and is closed out in accordance with the provisions of The Arkansas Solid Waste Disposal Code. (2) Proper preparation of the site shall be supervised and reported in writing to the Department by a Registered Professional Engineer prior to placement of any waste in the landfill. (3) Each of the groundwater monitoring wells and surface impoundments shall be analyzed quarterly during the first year of operation and twice annually thereafter unless more frequent monitoring is deemed necessary by the Department. Results shall be submitted to the Department after each analysis. The analysis shall include the following parameters: Cd, Fe, Pb, Zn, Mn, Chlorides, TDS, COD, pH, and Total Hardness. Additional monitoring wells shall be established as directed by the Department. (4) No process wastes will be accepted for disposal without specific written authorization from the Department. No Hazardous Waste of any kind or quantity will be disposed of in this facility. (5) This facility will not be available for use by the general public. Only United Sanitation will have access to this facility. No sign stating hours of operation will be required. (6) A clay liner shall be placed on the bottom and sides of each trench as outlined in the submitted engineering plans with provisions for additional liners over clayey silt areas as recommended in the Geotechnical investigation submitted with the application. Additional liner requirements may be specified by the Department as the operation develops. (7) In order to reduce traffic problems associated with crossing Highway 141, all landfill equipment shall remain on the acreage specified in this permit except for maintenance requirements that must be performed at United Sanitation Shop facilities located directly across Highway 141. (8) Due to the proximity of residents along Highway 141, areas designated E, F, G, in the submitted engineering plans shall not be utilized for waste disposal without written authorization from the Department. This authorization shall not be granted until an approved visual



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barrier is established between the residences and landfill operations. No waste disposal shall occur within 250 feet of an existing residence. Applicants shall submit revised plans for areas E, F, G to comply with this condition. (9) This permit shall not be effective unless the applicant files proof with the Department of recorded ownership of the realty or control of same with permission to use as a sanitary landfill pursuant to a recorded instrument.
