



SUBJECT: Request by Garland Coal Company for total remaining surety reduction on permit #120, based on permittee's compliance with the Interim program requirements.

A field trip was made on January 4, 1984, by the Mined Land Review Committee and the Department for inspection of final surface and revegetative results.
