

MINUTE ORDER NO. 84-85

Arkansas Water Quality Standards

A public hearing was held on March 5, 1984, to receive comments on the proposal by the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology to classify the watercourses described below in accordance with the provisions of Section 5(E) of the Arkansas Water Quality Standards, which provisions are commonly called the Intermittent Stream Policy. Comments were received at the time of the hearing on the proposed revisions of Appendix A of the Arkansas Water Quality Standards. Subsequently, these comments have been addressed.

The Commission hereby approves these revisions to the Arkansas Water Quality Standards (Regulation Number 2) with the classification of the following streams as intermittent.

- (1) Hughes Creek, which is tributary to Lick Creek, a tributary of the South Sylamore, is the receiving stream of the city of Mountain View.
- (2) Garland Creek, which is tributary to the Little Missouri River, is the receiving stream for the Firestone Tire and Rubber Company's Prescott plant.
