

A public hearing was held March 5, 1984 to receive comments on proposed revisions to the Water Quality Management Plan (208 Plan). Comments were received at the time of the hearing and subsequently, these comments have been addressed.

The Commission hereby approves updating the Water Quality Management Plan with the following additions and/or revisions:

- (1) Establishment of effluent limits from wasteload allocation studies for streams that are effluent dominated. (An effluent dominated stream is classified as one in which the majority of the stream flow, at the seven-day, 10 year, low flow condition is treated wastewater.) Effluent dominated stream status established are:
 - (a) Bayou Meto, which is the receiving stream for the city of Jacksonville,
 - (b) Prairie Creek, which is the receiving stream for the city of Mena.
- (2) Effluent limits were established by wasteload allocation studies for the following cities and respective receiving streams:
 - (a) Bentonville's discharge to Town Branch Creek,
 - (b) Cave City's discharge to Curia Creek,
 - (c) El Dorado's discharge to Bayou deLoutre,
 - (d) Eureka Springs discharge to Leatherwood Creek,
 - (e) Fayetteville's discharge to the White River and an Unnamed Tributary to Mud Creek,
 - (f) Flippin's discharge to Fallen Ash Creek, and
 - (g) Searcy's discharge to the Little Red River.
- (3) Effluent limits are established from wasteload allocation studies for the following that discharge into intermittent streams:
 - (a) The city of Mountain View which discharges to Hughes Creek, and
 - (b) Firestone Tire and Rubber Company Prescott Plant which discharges to Garland Creek.
