SUBJECT: Request by R. & S. Coal Company for an 85% reduction of surety posted on permit P241-M-CO.

Following a cursory check-out inspection, February 7, 1984, for full compliance with the operator's request, various reasons were pointed out to the operator for recommending that Phase I reduction of surety for 60% would be more acceptable at this time. This was agreed to by the operator.


A field trip for inspection was made on the above date by the Mined Land Review Committee members for approval of full compliance with Phase I reclamation and 60% reduction of surety posted on this permit.

Following the inspection, the Committee members agreed that the operator's reclamation efforts were acceptable.

On the basis of the operator's efforts, it is recommended by the Mined Land Review Committee that this operator's request for a 60% of surety be honored.
