SUBJECT: Request for release of Surety Bond by Weyerhaeuser Company on 46 acres located in Howard County.

Weyerhaeuser Company has requested the release of lands located in Howard County. The request for release from bond is on three parcels totaling 46 acres. The request is for 30 acres in the northwest corner and 11 acres in the northeast corner of section 14. Both of these areas are covered by permit #39. The third parcel is 5 acres in the southwest corner of section 11 which is covered by permit #40.


The Mined Land Review Committee and staff of the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology have inspected these areas and are in unanimous agreement that Weyerhaeuser has met the reclamation requirements of Act 336. Therefore release of the 46 acres is recommended.
