


Reynolds Metals Company has requested the release of surety bond for 40 acres covered by permit # 109A-2 Bauxite. The land is located in Section 25, T1N, R12W, in Pulaski County.

On February 27, 1987, McGeorge Contracting Company was issued a permit # 374 on this area. McGeorge Contracting has placed a \$20,000 surety bond up for this permit. McGeorge will be reclaiming the area with fines from a quarry operation.

The Mine Land Review Committee and the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology recommends, that the Commission honor this operator's request to release Reynolds from the surety bond and the permit.

Based on the above and attached information, the Commission hereby approves the operator's request.

SUBJECT: Bond Release of Reynolds Metals Company

Reynolds Metals Company has requested the release of its \$20,000 surety posted on 40 acres in Pulaski County. Normally a surety bond is not released until the property has been reclaimed; however, on February 27, 1987, McGeorge Contracting Company repermited this 40 acres, putting up a new \$20,000 bond. McGeorge Contracting Company will be reclaiming the open pits with reject crush stone material from a quarry operation.

Since McGeorge Contracting Company has replaced the bond and permit on this area, Department staff believes Reynold's bond should be released.

SUBJECT: Request for release of Surety Bond by Reynolds Metals Company on 40 acres in Pulaski County

Reynolds metals Company has requested the release of 40 acres in Pulaski County. The area is located in Section 25, T 1 N, R 12 W of Pulaski County.

The area was repermited by McGeorge Contracting Company on February 27, 1987. A \$20,000 bond was placed on the area by McGeorge. McGeorge Contracting Company is going to backfill the area with reject material from a quarry operation. There will be no mining in this area.

Since McGeorge Contracting Company is going to reclaim the area and has posted an adequate bond, it is the opinion of the Mined Land Review Committee and this writer that Reynolds Metals Company's surety bond should be released and the permit cancelled.

McGeorge Contracting Company, Inc. purchased Reynolds Metals Company property located in Section 25, township one north, range twelve west, Pulaski County, Arkansas.
