

WHEREAS, The Department, as a result of the inspections, hearing, and surveys, is aware of the economic problems the industry is experiencing, and

WHEREAS, The Department recognizes the fact that there are other disposal methods available, and

WHEREAS, The Commission has considered the factors enumerated at Ark. Stats. Ann. §82-1936.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, That cotton gin emissions shall comply with the provisions of the Air Code based upon the following compliance schedule:

(1) Cotton gins located in populated areas shall be in full compliance herewith no later than July 1, 1992, and

(2) Cotton gins located in remote or lightly populated areas shall be in full compliance herewith no later than July 1, 1995.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Commission finds that the Director shall enter into negotiations with each affected facility which results in an enforcement order that brings the facility into compliance no later than the above stated dates.
