COTTON GIN RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on May 22, 1987, the Commission adopted Minute Order 87-16 concerning variances for burning of waste material from cotton gins. This order requires cotton gins located in populated areas to be in compliance with the Air Code no later than July 1, 1992.

WHEREAS, the Commission conducted a public hearing on March 16, 1988, regarding cotton gin emissions and received statements from members of the public to the effect that emissions from cotton gins are a particular problem in populated areas.

WHEREAS, Minute Order 87-16 also found that the Director should enter into negotiations with each affected facility to enter into an enforcement order to bring the facility into compliance no later than the above stated date.

WHEREAS, although the compliance deadline in the order is a maximum time period, the order also allows gins to be in compliance prior to the deadline.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Director shall promptly negotiate a compliance schedule with those gins in populated areas. The goal of these negotiations shall be to achieve compliance in two years or less ^{(88-90 ginning seasons) MW} Included in the schedule shall be appropriate provisions requiring the cotton gin to demonstrate incremental progress towards compliance.
