

FINDINGS:

The Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology proposes to revise the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Supplement to the Regulations of the Arkansas Plan of Implementation for Air Pollution Control by adopting by reference the revised U.S. EPA PSD regulations, 40 CFR 52.21(b) through (r), as in effect on June 28, 1989. The primary purpose of this revision is to adopt the changes to the PSD regulations that EPA promulgated on October 17, 1988 (53 FR 40670), establishing air quality increments for nitrogen dioxide. By this adoption, the Department is also adopting several minor revisions to 40 CFR 52.21 that were made from October 17, 1988, through June 28, 1989.

ORDER:

After public notice and hearing and consideration of comments received, the revised Prevention of Significant Deterioration Supplement to the Regulations of the Arkansas Plan of Implementation for Air Pollution Control is hereby adopted.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This regulation and any amendment thereto shall be in full force and effect twenty days after filing with the Secretary of State.
