

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION ON POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY that the Director is encouraged to draft legislation to develop educational programs which will promote environmental responsibility and awareness, said program to be funded by fees and penalties currently collected and administered by the Department.
