










On May 30, 1990, ENVIROCLEAN, INC. was issued a permit (462-IR) to operate a commercial medical disposal facility of 250 lbs. of incineration per hour. On February 7, 1991, Enviroclean was issued permit (462-IR-1) which increased the capacity to 1,500 lbs. per hour. On August 14, 1991, a Notice of Permit Expiration was issued by the Director to Enviroclean, Inc. The Director revoked Enviroclean's permit because (1) Enviroclean stated on its application that it did not have a parent organization, (2) the permit provides that it was issued on the representation of the applicant, (3) Enviroclean sold 100 percent of its stock, and (4) this amounted to a transfer of the permit to another party and sale of the permitted facility which is prohibited by terms of the permit.


On November 6, 1991, the Department issued an Amended Notice of Expiration to Enviroclean alleging essentially the same reasons as in the original notice with the exception of spelling out the term "misrepresentation and failure to disclose." The hearing officer found that the addition did not raise a new issue to bolster the Department's action concerning the revocation.

Both parties agreed to waive a hearing and submit the administrative record and file briefs. After reviewing the administrative record and briefs, Judge Gibson rendered a Findings and Recommended Decision affirming the action of the Director in the revocation of Enviroclean's Permit No. 462-IR-1.

After reviewing the administrative record, including transcript, and the Findings and Recommended Decision of the hearing officer, and upon hearing arguments of ADPC&E and Enviroclean, Inc., the Commission affirms the Director's Decision.
