









Young made a motion to go back through the public hearing process on draft Regulation 22 with a modification to the end of the preamble to add the sentence "where fracturing and karsification have significantly influenced the strata." and Waddell seconded the motion. Discussion followed and it was noted that the draft presented for public hearing was not considered a final version and logical changes could be made. Further, it was noted that the adoption process for the regulation is to proceed without going through the Rules Committee for authorization. Williams called for the question. The motion (Minute Order 92-54) carried.
