

On January 28, 1994, Zeneca Inc. filed a Request for Rulemaking to Amend Regulation No. 2 to Adopt Federal Metals Criteria in Dissolved Form. This matter is Docket No. 94-009.







On March 17, 1994, Zeneca Inc's attorney, James F. Goodhart, filed a letter with the Commission Secretary stating that Zeneca, Inc. had decided to withdraw its request for rulemaking. Zeneca Inc. intends to support a similar rulemaking request previously filed with the Commission.
