A special meeting of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission ("Commission") is scheduled for Thursday, July 7, 1994, in the matter of Arkansas Medical Services Corp. ("AMS") which is Docket No. 93-232. The purpose of the special meeting is to consider and vote on the Administrative Hearing Officer's Recommended Decision concerning the revocation of Permit No. 464-I issued to AMS. The meeting shall commence at 9:00 a.m. and will be held at the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission offices located at #2 Natural Resource Drive, Little Rock, AR. The Chairman, in his discretion, is authorized to cancel the special meeting and reschedule this matter for a regular Commission meeting or a special Commission meeting.

The Commission believes it to be in the best interest of the public and the parties to describe the procedures which will be followed at the Commission meeting. Those procedures are:.

1. The Chairman shall permit members of the public time in which to make a statement to the Commission concerning this case. Time permitting, a person seeking to address the Commission may be allowed no more than three (3) minutes in which to make a statement. The three (3) minute time limit may be reduced at any point during the public comment period at the option of the Chairman.

The Chairman may close the public comment period at the end of one (1) hour, or sooner if all interested persons have completed their statements. The Chairman in his discretion, may extend the on (1) hour public comment period.

2. Mr. Samuel E. Ledbetter, attorney for Citizens for Progressive Development, in a letter dated May 10, 1994, requested an opportunity to address the Commission on this matter. Mr. Ledbetter will be permitted ten (10) minutes in which to address the Commission.

3. The attorneys representing the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology ("Department"), the Office of the Arkansas Attorney General ("AG"), and AMS will be permitted to make an oral argument to the Commission. Each side will be permitted twenty (20) minutes in which to orally argue their positions. The Department and the AG support revocation of the permit and they
