Pursuant to Consent Administrative Order LIS 93-073, ENSCO, Inc. has agreed to conduct a pilot Arkansas Public Schools Hazardous Waste Collection Program. The intent of the program is to assist Arkansas public school districts in properly managing hazardous waste generated as a result of the instructional use of chemicals and other materials. According to Commission Regulation No. 23 (Hazardous Waste Management), every school district for the 177 schools participating in the program would be required to either obtain a hazardous waste transportation permit or contract with a permitted transporter in order to take the wastes to central collection points established by ENSCO, Inc. Compliance with this requirement would cause undue hardship on the schools, while noncompliance would cause no substantially adverse environmental effects.

Therefore, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §8-7-211, the Commission hereby grants a waiver to all schools participating in the Arkansas Public Schools Hazardous Waste Collection Program. Since hazardous waste transportation permits in Arkansas are issued jointly by the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology and the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department ("AHTD"), this waiver is conditioned upon the issuance of a similar waiver by the AHTD.
