
Pursuant to the authority provided by the Emergency Response Fund Act, Act 452 of 1985, as amended, codified as A.C.A. Sec.8-7-401 et seq., an Emergency Order (LIS No. 95-077) was issued on May 23, 1995, by the Director of the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology ("the Department"), to Rixey Iron and Metal Company and other parties. The Order was issued to prevent future releases or migration of hazardous substances, including polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), at the Rixey site located at 8033 Old Jacksonville Highway, North Little Rock, Arkansas. The site contains hazardous substance and PCB contamination of unknown levels and poses a threat to the public health, welfare, and safety and the environment.







ADPC&E inspectors visited the Rixey site on December 21, 1994, and again on May 15, 1995. The inspectors observed what they believed to be PCB-contaminated materials and other possible hazardous substances. These materials were first located in drums and tanks at the site. Upon further investigation, the suspect product was also located in an impounded area. Analysis revealed that PCBs in excess of 50 ppm and highly flammable materials existed on site.


According to Department estimates, the cost of securing the site will be approximately \$252,210.

The Commission hereby authorizes the Director to expend funds in excess of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) to complete the interim remedial action as described in the Emergency Order.
