




WHEREAS, organized local cleanup activities are scheduled to begin April 19, 1997, to continue through May 4, 1997; and





WHEREAS, this worthy effort should be endorsed by all institutions of the State and should be widely publicized to promote public participation and support.


**THESE PREMISES CONSIDERED, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ARKANSAS
