Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-202 allows the Commission to impose an immediate moratorium on categories or types of permits if it determines that there is an imminent peril to the public health, safety or welfare. Moratoriums adopted under an emergency declaration shall be effective for no longer than one hundred and eighty (180) days.

It is therefore, ORDERED,

The Commission determines that continuing to issue permits allowing gravel mining in Crooked Creek presents an imminent peril to the public welfare. Therefore, an immediate moratorium on the issuance of such permits is hereby imposed. This emergency moratorium will expire in one hundred and eighty (180) days.
