

On January 6, 1999, The City of Huntsville, Arkansas, filed a Motion to Dismiss its Petition to Initiate Third Party Rulemaking to Amend Regulation No. 2 ("Petition").

The Motion stated that the reason it was being filed was because the City had received sufficient grant moneys to enable it to upgrade its wastewater treatment plant to meet the requirements of the city's NPDES discharge permit, and it was therefore no longer necessary for financial reasons for the City to pursue a change of water quality standards in order to seek a modification of the permit effluent limits.

The Commission approves the Motion to Dismiss the City of Huntsville's Petition to Initiate Third Party Rulemaking.
