**Call to Order**

Commissioner Young called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m.

**Quorum**

Commission Secretary called roll and a quorum was declared.

**Approval of Minutes**

Chair Young asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the October meeting. Commissioner Thompson moved to approve the minutes and Commissioner Sickel seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

**Regulation No. 14, Regulations and Administrative Procedures for the Waste Tire Program; Docket No. 11-006-R.**

Ms. Lorielle Gutting stated that ADEQ proposes to initiate this rulemaking to incorporate legislative changes, as well as to update the definitions of automobile tire and truck tire to bring them current with industry standards. She asked the Committee to recommend adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission.

Commissioners asked questions and discussion followed.

Commissioner Sickel made a motion to recommend adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission. Commissioner Hendrix seconded the motion. The motion passed.

**Regulation No. 9, Fee Regulation; Docket No. 11-007-R.**

Mr. Mike Porta explained that the proposed regulatory amendments exclude carbon dioxide and methane from being chargeable emissions under air permit fees under section 0.502. Under current proposed

changes to Regulation Numbers 18, 19, and 26, greenhouse gases, including carbon dioxide and methane, will be permitted. Minor typographical errors have been corrected within the body of the regulation. He asked the Committee to recommended adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission.

Commissioner Hendrix made a motion to recommend the adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission. Commissioner White seconded the motion. The motion passed.

### **Regulation No. 30, Arkansas Hazardous Substances Remedial Action Trust Fund Site Priority List; Docket No. 11-008-R.**

Mr. Clyde Rhodes stated that this proposed revision would delete five (5) sites where cleanup has been completed, and add one (1) site for investigation and potential remediation. He asked the Committee to recommended adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission.

Commissioner Sickel made a motion to recommend the adoption of the minute order initiating the rulemaking process to the Commission. Commissioner White seconded the motion. The motion passed.
