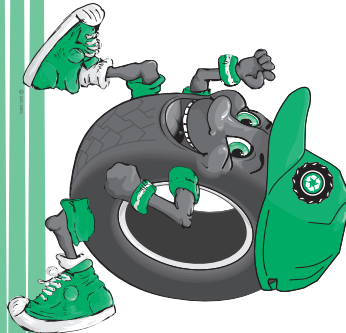

## License Program



### WHO needs a Waste Tire Transporter License?

- Any person who transports 25 waste, used or processed tires from one place to another.

*You are required to maintain liability insurance on your vehicle at all times. Renewal for the Waste Tire Transporter License is once a year with annual reports due each February.*



### HOW do you get your Waste Tire Transporter License?

- Complete an ADEQ Disclosure Form, and Forms TP1 and TP2 from the Waste Tire Program Information Packet
- Return the completed forms along with a copy of your drivers license(s), proof of liability insurance on your vehicle(s), and license fees in the amount of \$35 per vehicle or a maximum of \$250 for fleets.

*Remember, a Waste Tire Transporter must leave waste, used and processed tires for storage or disposal only at a permitted waste tire processing facility, at a permitted solid waste management facility, at a permitted waste tire collection center, or at another site approved by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality.*
