From a letter to a friend:

Consider this, McVeigh may have been crazy by our standards, but I wonder what he knew that we do not know? If you will remember, he never talked, even while he lay there looking into the eyes of the victim's relatives. He obviously thought he had done what a good soldier should have done. I only wish he had given an answer to that question, as it will haunt me until the day I die.

McVeigh was a Dessert Storm veteran, and I can't help but wonder how he came to despise the government the way he did. What could he have learned that could have turned him against his country? How many more Wacos', Ruby Ridges', Oklahoma Cites' are we going to have? Again, I wish he had given an answer! We, the American people, were so shocked to find out that a "Red Blooded American Boy," just like you or I had done such a thing. Prior to that event, we would not have even dared to think such a heinous act could have been possible. Everyone rushed to judgement in thinking the despicable act of terrorism had been committed by some "Middle Eastern" person or group of people.

Boo, you and I were raised in Franklin, Louisiana, at a time in the history of this country that can never be recaptured. We were blessed to have had the privelege of living in, what I would describe as, the most perfect town in the US, at a time when the country was still young and very innocent. I have a vivid memory of walking down Main Street, among the "Historic Live Oaks' and the 'White Lampposts,' and thinking to myself, 'gee, I am lucky I live here;' what a fantastic time to have been young and what a fantastic place to enjoy that youthful phase of our lives. We can, most assuredly, be thankful that we spent that part of our lives when we did and where we were.

Those days were so much simpler, and no person or group of people could even imagine that anything so sinister could possibly be out in the world at large. America had supposedly fought the war that was to end all wars, and as a child, I could sense the relief and optimism that was part of the post World War II atmosphere.

The A&P put their crates of fresh produce on the sidewalk every morning and cleaned off the sidewalk every evening. The Western Auto rolled out all of their brand new bicycles and lawn mowers every morning and wheeled back into the store those that remained every evening. There were no Wal-Marts to clutter the landscape, and downtown America was open for business. We knew who worked in and who owned every business in town, and it was a time when people took pride in their workmanship and made in USA was the emblem that the whole world looked up to with ultimate respect.

Goods made in America were made from material of superior quality, and when you made a purchase, you could count on having bought a product that was made to last.

Those days had real pharmacies, complete with soda-fountains, and even featured a pre -Christmas visit from Santa Clause. I can still recall sitting on Santa's lap in St. Mary Pharmacy spilling my guts as to what I wanted for Christmas; little did I know that the Santa was my very own Father.

We always had a season for "Marbles," in the fall, and the age of "Television" was just making its way into American households all over the country, "Radio" was still the most utilized media, and we dared not miss a Friday night fight. Kids don't play marbles anymore, and television is only watched ocassionally when the computer is on the blink. We don't even listen to the radio anymore, that has taken a back seat to CD Players in the automobile.

Our whole country is now comprised of corrupt career politicians who are interested in self-promotion, and they are completely out of touch with the people who elevated them to the status that they now enjoy. I don't think this is exactly what our "Founding Fathers" had in mind when framing the constitution. Right and wrong were such simple things when we were growing up, but today, politics is largely responsible for defining what is right or wrong, and profit and greed have been inserted as appropriate substitutes. It no longer matters who is swallowed up by corporate greed, the bottom line is the only thing that matters anymore. How many families have been devastated by downsizing of corporate America? How many people have been displaced from a career that once gave them a tremendous amount of self esteem? The downsizing was preceeded by hostile takeovers, mergers, and acquisitions. The bottom line is more important than satisfied and valued employees who strived to do their very best at their chosen profession. Profit is the only thing that is important anymore, and the more profit a company makes the higher it is held in esteem by the politicians they have bought.

Today, young people are sent to foreign lands to fight for what is supposed to be right. Have you ever noticed that what American politicians want is the standard that is used to measure what is right for the whole world? We are going to other countries to liberate the "oppressed people," but when that mission has been accomplished, American military presence is permantly left in place to oversee the actions of the people of the countries who were previously ruled by dictators. Those dictators have been replaced by Americans, and by the same standard, "might is right." So I must ask, has anything really changed?

We may not have had the greatest football team in the state, but we played hard every game, and we got to know who we could count on when the going got rough. We may not have won many games, but we cultivated a healthy respect for one another. We played because we loved the game, and we played because we were proud of our school, and we played because our siblings had played just before we did. They were our role models, and that is another thing that has changed today. The kids of today don't have older siblings who played the game, and I guess that is what happened to marbles too.

Downtown America has had to find creative ways to restore these boarded up areas. Historic Districts have been created and various means have been employed to preserve what has been replaced by sprawling shopping malls just outside of town. Franklin tragically lost its former Court House to a modern day version of the "Shoe-Box!" What a beautiful edifice sacrificed for a totally functional abomination. That is a perfect example of how our value system has not only been changed but totally displaced.

We grew up in the south during the '40's, '50's, and '60's, and we were there when mothers stayed home to take care of their families and fathers went to work to support those families. However, at the end of that timeframe, things began to change, and mothers were forced to go out into the workforce to help support the family unit. This is probably the most negative social change that we have lived through during our lifetime. Families were once much closer and well balanced than they are today, and the single most important factor involved is the absence of "mamma" when a child gets home after spending a day in school. This is responsible for the "Latch-Key" child generation, and this could hold the key as to why we have changed so dramatically as a society.

Now back to Iraq we have gone; is it for oil? Is it because George "Dub Yah" Bush really cares about those people's freedom? If he cares so much about people, why does your Mother in Law find it necessary to purchase her prescription medications from Canada? Why will you have to pay taxes on what little social security you will finally collect? Why does Congress not pay into social security? Did you give them the right to transfer that money into the general fund? I don't remember being asked if they could use my money. Why is it that Congress was able to vote a perk for themselves that allows them to retire with millions, free health care, and live a lifestyle that you or I can only dream of? Why is it that immigrants from other nations qualify for social security benefits when they never payed a dime into the system? Why is it that they can make laws that benefit only those privileged few? Are they better than you and I? Why are we denied disability when we are hurting? Why is it that we cannot retain much of what we presently earn? Why are we taxed so heavily?

I can ask why to thousands of issues, but I keep coming back to the government that, supposedly, we, the people, control! We have the right to bitch about the vote that we cast and the right to cast that vote, and the right to worship as we please, but do we really have any real rights that make a difference in our lifestyle? Oh yes, we still have the right to bear arms, but don't be fooled into thinking that some one or some group is not always at work trying to take that right away from you. As you and I sleep, Congress is making back room deals, in smoke filled rooms, and you can bet it is not to benefit the interests of you or I.

The environment was once something that Americans treasured and cared for with pride, but now the Secretary of the Interior recently abolished the protection of 107 million acres of federal land that had been set aside as permanent wilderness areas. This was done with the stroke of a pen late on a Friday afternoon. The Bush administration has demonstrated that it is far more interested in exploiting public lands for commercial purposes than it is in protecting these aesthetically valuable lands. Big business is the only winner in this game, and timber companies, oil and gas companies, and mining companies are jumping for joy as these sacred places are opened up for exploitation. We sent these people to Washington to serve us, but over the years, they have enslaved the American worker, and now we work to serve them! Again, I am forced to wonder if that is the way our "Founding Fathers" planned the "State of the Nation!"

My family has had our rights violated, here in Arkansas, by an unscrupulous "Real Estate" agent and a convicted felon to whom he purportedly sold a small amount of land that adjoins our property. The man who lived next door to us for about three years is currently incarcerated in Michigan, but the agent remains free and continues to engage in reprehensible land deals. It has always been my contention that the real estate man should not have ever been allowed to enjoy freedom once he reached the age of majority.

Once my non-chosen neighbor was, again, apprehended for counterfeiting, I reported the squalor and unsightly piles of "Air Conditioner Compressors," "Batteries" on the ground, "Drums of Oil" leaking into the soil, "Old Tires and Rims," and dozens of electrical and mechanical items left out in the open, to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality. ADEQ supposedly conducted an investigation of the waste site, and without the benefit of a single soil sample or water sample, they came to the incomprehensible conclusion that, "There was no hazardous waste on that site!"

I then called in the "Environmental Protection Agency," EPA, but they were told to "Back Off," as the state had things under control. It goes without saying that the corruption of politics has precluded a proper investigation into the problem, and a totally inept agency in the "Natural State" was allowed to abdicate their responsibility. However, after seeing and communicating with this group of grossly incompetent individuals, I feel certain that they were quite relieved that their ignorance and apathy would not be publicly exposed.

Yes, I have been a law abiding citizen for the vast majority of my life, but I give more thought to everything today. Over the years, I have become more cynical about the way the ordinary American citizen is controlled by such a very small...out of touch... fragment of our society. Why would anyone spend a million dollars to get elected to a job that only pays 100 thousand dollars a year? Who contributes to the war chests of these entrenched politicians? What does their lobbying dollar buy for them? How does one gain access to the ear of an influential politician? Could it be through those dollars that were contributed prior to their election? The dollars buy access to the powers that be, and it buys their votes on issues that affect big business. However, when it comes to paying taxes, you and I are helpless, hapless, and financially embarrassed.

I once got goose bumps every time I heard the National Anthem, but today I change the channel or turn off the radio or just walk away. Am I less patriotic because of the way I feel or lack to feel? Has my country treated me as well as I have treated it? The National Anthem once meant something to me that gave rise to great visceral feelings, but today it just lets me know that ten basketball players will have shortly earned millions of dollars while school teachers, policemen and firefighters are not even able to afford to pay the price of admission. Why have our priorities gotten so out of balance? What have we done to deserve such a life?

At the end of the day, I may have earned 2 or 3 hundred dollars, but what am I allowed to keep? It really doesn't matter how much you earn if you must give it back anyway. Why is it that our government is allowed to throw our money away to every "Banana Republic" in the world? Did they bother to ask you whether or not you had anything to say about how the money is spent?

Please give some thought to what I have said, and perhaps you will not be so forgiving of the people who are so benevolent to some and so unforgiving to you and I.

Dear Guy:

Thank you for contacting me regarding proposals to repeal the taxation of Social Security benefits.

..and I thank you for opening up a dialogue with me on the subject of Social Security benefits.

I understand it is frustrating to pay taxes throughout your work history to qualify for Social Security benefits, only to have those benefits taxed when you retire. As you know, current law dictates that if a Social Security recipients' threshold income exceeds \$34,000 (single) or \$44,000 (couples), up to 85% of their benefits is subject to income tax. I am concerned that this taxation places some seniors in a financial predicament after the government promised that Social Security would be there to help them in their golden years. Please rest assured that I will work for fair tax treatment of your Social Security benefits as Congress considers proposals to reform Social Security.

That is very interesting! I wonder if you really do have any idea how frustrating it is to pay into a totally inequitable system from the age of 18 until a projected retirement age of 66 to 70. If you are so knowledgeable and concerned about the frustration that working people feel, then I wonder if you would be willing to give up your present retirement plan and begin paying into the same Social Security system that I have been paying into since that age of 18? I went to work in the offshore oil-field the day after I graduated from High School, and I was fortunate enough to make and save enough money each summer and one Christmas to finance my entire college education.

I am not saying that I would not have welcomed a "Care Package" more than once, and I went to bed hungry more than a few nights during my five year tenure in college. However, I was able to separate wants from needs, and I made the sacrifices that were imperative to stay enrolled in school. I don't wish to dramatize my college experience here, because those days can be the best days in any person's life. College is a place where one can form life-long friendships and exchange ideas and thoughts with people who have come from entirely different backgrounds. The common thread is that everyone is striving to attain a goal that sets the stage for the rest of your life. You work hard in college, and you expect to realize the gains as you enter into adulthood and become part of the workforce. The hope is to earn a decent living for yourself and your family, and the key to doing so is inseparable from the fact that one must be allowed to keep as much of one's earnings as is possible. That, of course, is far from reality today. We are so over-taxed, and have been for many years, that it is impossible to keep enough of what we earn to achieve the objectives described above.

Tonight as I sit here and reflect on the past 36 years as a licensed professional and having practiced in several states, I realize just how many things are inequitable in life, however this is not a perfect world in which we live, and as long as we have greed and corruption at all levels of government, from the local level to the top of the ladder, life is not likely to get any better. It certainly does not take a mental giant to figure out that when an individual spends \$1,000,000 to get elected to a job that pays \$50,000 per year, there is an obscene amount of money that finds its way into the pockets of the successful candidates.

It pains me to see, every day of my life, so many older people who once thought they would be financially secure at the age of retirement. Today, in this country, it is the exception rather than the rule that an individual does not need to worry about outliving their money! Abject poverty is probably the most unbecoming and demeaning human condition that life has to offer.

Through my positions on the Senate Finance Committee and the Senate Special Committee on Aging, I will continue to work with the President and my colleagues on a plan to make our Social Security system fiscally sound for its future beneficiaries.

Now, the paragraph above is the one that particularly impugnes my intelligence and my integrity. You know, quite well, that the "President," and your colleagues, could care less about the quality of life that exists for the people of this country, and unless one of the future beneficiaries is your child, then it is highly unlikely that there is great concern for future beneficiaries. I have witnessed so many individuals who are turned down over and over for disability benefits. The people to whom I am referring, would need to present at a federal office with their death certificate in the hands of the spouse.

We once had a sound plan that allowed for the Social Security system to remain fiscally sound for eternity. It was not until monies that were "Social Security Contributions" were transferred into the general fund that the system ran into problems. If you people in Washington...Democrats in Particular.... had not seen fit to get your hands on that money, we would not be having this discussion tonight. Money would be readily available for the physically and mentally infirm and the elderly population who have made so many sacrifices for and contributions to this country throughout their lives. I know you feel as though you and your colleagues are doing a fine job, but I am totally baffled as to how you folks can look into the mirror!

I appreciate knowing your views on this important issue. Please know that I will continue my work to ensure the solvency of Social Security and improve the quality of life for all older Americans, and don't hesitate to contact me again if I may be of any assistance to you.

It is very reassuring that you will continue to work on freeing up the tax burden on older Americans, but I wonder if you are equally as dedicated to cutting the pensions and retirement plans of the members of the House and also the Senate. I would also like to know your position on immigrants, who have never paid into the Social Security system, however they are entitled to allocations of monthly benefits that should belong to the people who made regular deposits into the fund.. Americans have worked so hard to earn their slice of that pie, and it is an egregious injustice that the real contributors have been forced to accept less so that undeserving immigrants become eligible to receive benefits.

Builders say plan no threat to river
Court hears battle over island homes

Developers planning a 42-lot subdivision on an island in the White River clashed in federal court Monday with environmentalists who argued that the proposed Eagle's Landing neighborhood poses a threat to the river's water quality.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the developers of Eagle's Landing filed an appeal hoping to avoid public hearings and environmental impact studies ordered by U.S. District Judge Bill Wilson in February.

During a two-hour hearing, attorneys for the Corps and the developers said the extra measures would be expensive, time-consuming and potentially unnecessary.

The Arkansas Nature Alliance, a nonprofit environmental group, filed suit in April 2002 when the Corps of Engineers granted a request from developers David Sharp, Dennis Wilson, Tony Stewart and Ernest Lamb for a permit to build up a low water bridge to the mile-long island near Allison in Stone County without opening the issue up to public comment.

Wilson declined to rule Monday, but pledged to issue a ruling soon.

Plans for the Stone County island have changed substantially, said attorney Alan Perkins, who represents the developers. The changes reduce any potential environmental impact on the White River, negating the need for public hearings and an environmental impact study that would cost thousands of dollars and take months to complete, he said.

The bridge to Landers Island that now hovers uncomfortably close to the river channel will be torn down and replaced with a higher span bridge, he said.

Subdivision lines have been redrawn, leaving larger lots on higher ground.

"Twelve and a half lots have been deleted," Perkins said.

Although the island's low elevation leaves it nearly completely immersed during 50-year floods, all septic tanks will be installed at a high point on the island to protect against post-flood pollution downstream, Perkins said.

Fletcher Jackson, an attorney for the Corps, agrees changes to developers' plans make the project less of a threat to the environment and should qualify the development for a permit that doesn't require public hearings and in-depth environmental studies.

"This is quite different than what we were here about before," Jackson said.

But Richard Mays, an attorney for the Arkansas Nature Alliance, said the new plan for development still tempts Mother Nature during flood conditions and endangers water quality downstream.

"It's an improvement, but not by any means a desirable situation," he said.

The National Environmental Protection Act of 1969 requires federal agencies to assess the environmental impact of "significant actions," and issuing a permit for the development of the flood-prone Landers Island qualifies, he said.

The Corps simply wants to get out of having to follow the rules, he said.

"They're not accustomed to being challenged," Mays said.

New Scientific Discovery

The National Research Council (NRC) has recently announced the discovery of the heaviest chemical element yet known to science.

The new element has been tentatively named Governmentium.

Governmentium has 1 neutron, 12 assistant neutrons, 75 deputy neutrons, and 224 assistant deputy neutrons, giving it an atomic mass of 312.

These 312 particles are held together by forces called morons, which are surrounded by vast quantities of lepton-like particles called peons.

RE: Letter Dated January 2, 2003, In Regard To Guy Stirling.

Dear Senator Lincoln:

I am in receipt of your letter dated January 2, 2003, in which you inquired about Mr. Guy Stirling's concerns regarding possible environmental hazards adjacent to his home.

The Solid Waste Management Division of ADEQ conducted an investigation into a complaint filed by Mr. Stirling against Mr. Richard Curtis. The investigation occurred on October 4, 2001, and small amounts of waste were found to be disposed at a site for which a permit had not been issued by the Department. The results of the investigation found Mr. Curtis in violation of the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act. However, with Mr. Curtis being in prison, ADEQ had no other responsible party to pursue. This dump site did not warrant an emergency, therefore no further action was taken by the Department.

On February 21, 2002, Mr. Stirling electronically mailed the Solid Waste Management Division's District Inspector to advise he was not to be contacted by any means whatsoever. Therefore, the Department severed communications with Mr. Stirling.

The Attorney General's office, Environmental Division, has also investigated this complaint. Currently their investigation is on hold due to threatening e-mails from Mr. Stirling.

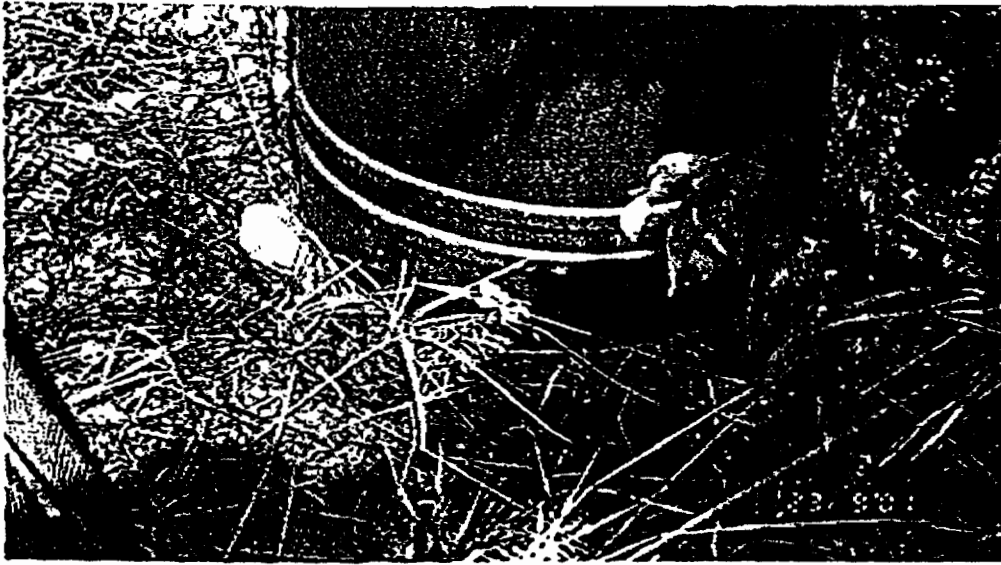

Mr. Meador,

I am happy to report that the group of physicians that I was seeing in Mountain Home were dead wrong about my lung condition!

My brother in Louisiana, a general surgeon, and an Agri-Teacher, also in Louisiana finally put all of the pieces of the puzzle together. I have Hypersensitivity Pneumonitis or Allergic Alveolitis; just fancy words to say that I have developed an allergy to pigeon proteins.

Dr. Scott Snodgrass, in Jonesboro, finally found out what specific test was required to make the diagnosis. It was his first case of "Pigeon Breeder's Lung Disease", and it took him several days to find out what the specific test panel was and where I needed to go to find a lab that ran that panel. It turns out that I have elevated antibodies to several related substances, but (by far) pigeon droppings is the most remarkable. The normal IGg for pigeon droppings on this panel is <12.5ug/ml and my reading came back at >200ug/ml. The scale only measures as high as 200, so > is anything up to infinity!

I, very reluctantly, gave my birds away, and my pulmonary function studies have returned to normal!

So, it looks as though I may be around to finish my business with ADEQ, David Sharp, and Robert Curtis after all!

This investigation was in response to a complaint alleging the open dumping of waste. My investigation revealed that you are in violation of the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act, A.C.A. § 8-6-205. Specifically, I found the following violation(s):

Operation of an unpermitted solid waste disposal facility, which is in violation of §8-6-205 (a)(1)(2)(3)(4) and (5). **"No person shall dispose of solid waste at any disposal site or facility other than a disposal site or facility for which a permit has been issued by the Department".**
