Subject: Craighead County Demolition Complaint

Last Thursday (May 18) I received an anonymous complaint on a highway project borrow pit/fill area and dump site that was likely to cause pollution to the Waters of the State. I investigated the complaint and found that several thousand cubic yards of dirt will be excavated and used as highway base and fill material. I also found that demolition waste (lumber, shingles, wiring, carpet, insulation & a few tires) from several condemned houses in Jonesboro had been hauled to the site. The complainant stated that there was asbestos siding on the houses and was unsure if proper procedures had been followed regarding removal and disposal. I spoke with the property owner Friday morning and he stated that the demolition wastes were going to be burned that evening. He was immediately informed by me and later by Air Division inspector Coy Dobson that burning the wastes would result in enforcement action by the department. The owner's intensions were to burn the demolition wastes and to bury the remaining material in the borrow pit once all excavation was complete. He was told to contact solid waste regarding proper disposal of the material which would most likely require him to take it to an approved landfill. I will be working with the highway department contractor regarding proper permitting of the borrow pit as it relates to the Water Division, but the site definitely warrants investigation by the Solid Waste Division and likely the Air Division - Asbestos Section.

Location: West of Jonesboro on Hwy 349 South of Westside School, turn onto the field road (West side of Hwy) immediately across from CR 114. Follow the field road past the white PVC fence and the dump will be to visible to the left approximately 100 yards before the road ends. 35.829784°, -90.813458°

The demolition wastes allegedly originated from Olive St., Cherry St. and Washington Ave. in Jonesboro.

Be advised that Mr. Gibson was rather uncooperative and almost hostile.

Dear Mr. Gibson:

On May 31, 2006, I performed an investigation of your property located west of Hwy 349 in Craighead County. This investigation was in response to a complaint alleging that you are allowing others to dump waste at this location. My investigation revealed that you are in violation of the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act, A.C.A. § 8-6-205. Specifically, I found the following violation(s):

Operation of an unpermitted solid waste disposal facility, which is in violation of \$8-6-205 (a) (1),(2)&(5). The waste dumped at this site consists of Demolition Waste. **"No person shall dispose of solid waste at any disposal site or facility other than a disposal site or facility for which a permit has been issued by the Department**".

By law, anyone who violates any provision of the Solid Waste Management Act may be subject to criminal, administrative and civil penalties up to \$10,000.

You should immediately cease the activity described above and undertake measures to correct the violation. You should notify me in writing at the above letterhead address or call (870) 935-7221 EXT 13, within **20 days** of the date of this letter, with a plan of action for correcting the violation.

Please be advised that failure to make contact with me in regard to this notification may warrant formal enforcement. Your cooperation is appreciated.
