SECTION 4 Violations

Solid Waste Management Act §8-6-205

(a)(2) To construct, install, alter, modify, use or operate any solid waste processing or disposal facility or disposal site without a permit from the department

(a)(3) To dispose of solid wastes at any disposal site or facility other than a disposal site or for which a permit has been issued by the department

(a)(3) Individual's household disposal that creates a public or private nuisance or a hazard to health and/or violates a city ordinance or other law and/or involves the open dumping of garbage

(a)(4) To dump, deposit, throw, or in any manner leave or abandon any solid wastes upon property owned by another person without the written permission of the owner or upon public property

(a)(5) To sort, collect, transport, process, or dispose of solid waste contrary to the rules, regulations or orders of the department, or create or likely to create a public nuisance or public health hazard or to cause or likely to cause water or air pollution (Ark. Water and Air Pollution Control Act §8-4-101 et seq)

(a)(5)(b) A rebuttal presumption when one (1) or more items of solid waste bear the name to indicate that the person committed the unlawful act of disposal

Air Pollution Control Code §8-4-310(a)(1)(2)(3)

5)(a) No person shall cause or permit the open burning of refuse, garbage, trade wastes or other waste material, or shall conduct a salvage operation by open burning

Investigation Comments

I investigated the site on 11-18-10 and observed mostly the charred remains of a waste tire pile located at a gravel mining pit off Big Stone road in Fulton County. Although most of the tires were completely burned the pile was still burning at this time. Also, at the site I observed a burning dozer deck with the remains of burned tires and below the dozer deck was several whole waste tires. I spoke with an Equipment Operator who was excavating gravel at the site and he stated that the property owner was Shawn Batterton. The operator was reluctant to provide any additional information about the tires.

11-18-10, Left a voice mail for Darrell Zimmer, Fulton County OEM, requesting additional information.

11-18-10. Received a return call from Darrell Zimmer. He confirmed that Shawn Batterton was the property owner and that he operated J&J Tire Shop in Salem. Mr. Zimmer will e-mail additional information to my office on Monday.
