prior to backfilling excavation – will address electrical, water, and phone needs as soon
as excavation is filled and fence along driveway is installed

#### Main Street

No change - continue monitoring and maintenance activities

#### 365

 Addressing a small area near 365 along creek where small amount of oil was found – looks like some type of void in ground that captured some oil

#### Cove

- Continue monitoring and maintenance, including airboat pom-pom operations
- Working with ADEQ and AGF to finalize boom removal strategy

#### Other

- Have generated additional roll offs (hydro-vacing)
- Generated some additional decon water from frac tank cleaning will go to Rineco
