Great Lakes Chemical Corporation—Central Facility (GLCC) is seeking to amend Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Regulation No. 2, Regulation Establishing Water Quality Standards for Surface Waters of the State of Arkansas, to: (a) modify the chloride, sulfate and total dissolved minerals (TDS) criteria of the Arkansas Water Quality Standards (WQS) and remove the designated, but not existing, domestic water supply use for an unnamed tributary to Bayou de Loutre (referred to hereafter as UT002); (b) modify the chloride and TDS criteria and remove the designated, but not existing, domestic water supply use for a second unnamed tributary to Bayou de Loutre (referred to hereafter as UT004); (c) modify the chloride criteria and remove the designated, but not existing, domestic water supply use for a portion of the Bayou de Loutre; (d) modify the chloride, sulfate and TDS criteria and remove the designated, but not existing, domestic water supply use for an unnamed tributary to an unnamed tributary of Little Cornie Bayou (hereafter referred to as UT003); (e) modify the chloride and TDS criteria and remove the designated, but not existing, domestic water supply use for an unnamed tributary to Little Cornie Bayou; and (f) modify the chloride and sulfate criteria for a portion of Little Cornie Bayou.
