I support, as a citizen of AR, the proposed changes to ADEQ Reg 5 + 6 which prohibits the ADEQ Director from issuing NO 5 + No 6 permits for facilities in the Buffalo National River (with either 750 or more swine ^{weighing 55 lbs or more} or 3,000 or more swine weighing less than 55 pounds).

Personally, I believe the numbers of swine should be much less than the proposed prohibition states because of the amount of damage swine feces can do to rivers of karst terrain UNLESS there is a ~~STATE~~ WASTE WATER Treatment Plant connected with CATS operations, rather than waste lagoons. I recommend these prohibitions be lowered in numbers of swine because there is NO WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT connected to these (contact)
