I'm in support of the proposed changes to Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Regulation 6 to include notification procedures whenever an applicant files a Notice of Intent for a General Permit for a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation. I would recommend the following additions: A) Language under 6.207(A) specifying that "written, published and emailed" notification be issued no more than 30 days prior to submission of the Notice of Intent. B) The Arkansas Department of Health should be included in the list of entities to be notified. C) The location of a proposed facility within the watershed of a national park should be communicated to the National Park Service.
