 7. What is the purpose of this proposed rule? Why is it necessary? This proposed rule revises the state air code (non-federally enforceable regulations) to be consistent with federal rule changes made after EPA's periodic reevaluation and revisions of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards and other federal air pollution control regulations. These changes will also provide greater clarity to Regulation No. 18 and eliminate typographical and formatting errors. This proposed rule is necessary to ensure that the Arkansas regulation is not in conflict with federal rules that have been federally adopted. Also, by revising Regulation No. 18, ADEQ will be able to issue permits for fine particulate matter. Because the National Ambient Air Quality Standard for particulate matter is a health-based standard, this rule change will allow ADEQ to protect human health and the environment from detrimental effects of fine particulate matter. Additional substantive changes were made to Regulation No. 18 with the intention of updating Regulation No. 18 to be more closely aligned with federal rules. All other changes were made as updates, clarifications, and error corrections. 8.
