Good Afternoon-

Please consider this a public comment on the AIM/CPP draft documents.

This is a request to extend the public comment period beyond August 26, 2020--by either 30 or 60 days. The CPP and AIM documents are both complicated and important to the future of water quality in Arkansas. We should take the time now to constructively improve them through public input and critique.

Several matters, which the agency has been aware of for years, including through two stakeholder processes, are not addressed by the AIM and CPP. I suggest, in the alternative, that the agency withdraw the current documents, and put forth CPP and AIM documents (as soon as possible, with a new public comment period) that incorporate stakeholder input, thus moving the documents forward, and lessening the need for extensive public comments and later revision.
