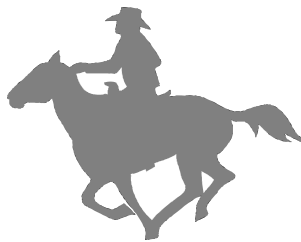

The Silver and Quicksilver Messenger Service Project (“SAQMS”) goal is to eliminate and reduce silver and mercury discharges into the environment through common sense management practices.

Can you reduce pollution? Yes.

Pollution Prevention (P2) opportunities exist at all levels of business activities. Learning how will benefit both the environment and your company’s bottom line.

These meetings will show you practices that can be implemented at your workplace. Together we can significantly reduce the amount of silver and mercury being discharged into municipal sewage systems and the environment.

Attend and Learn:

- How to implement P2 practices to eliminate or reduce discharges of silver and mercury.
- About existing Federal laws regarding disposal methods.
- How to partner with others to protect the Natural State.
- How cities can use P2 Best Management Practices in lieu of permits.
- About EPA’s focus on mercury. All sources of mercury may face regulations pertaining to management, treatment, and disposal if voluntary measures are not enacted. **Now is the time to act!**

Who Should Attend These Meetings?

Plan to attend if your workplace:

- Conducts photo imaging
- Processes x-ray film
- Uses materials or equipment containing mercury and silver such as print shops, dental, medical, chiropractic and veterinary practices.

City pretreatment coordinators, wastewater superintendents and managers and others responsible for the protection of wastewater treatment plants and receiving stream’s water quality should also attend.

Meeting Format

The three-hour meeting will be repeated three times during the day to fit your work schedule. Industry experts in P2 will outline cost-effective equipment alternatives, operation and maintenance, and employee training issues. You’ll learn about Best Management Practices applicable to your business.
