You're receiving form letter comments from other Audubon Society members and supporters that detail ADEQ specific actions. I won't travel their formatted path. However, I will state I believe the creek warrants increased attention, prioritization, and studies because the amount of visible garbage flies in the face of your current position to say nothing of pathogenic indicator bacteria and other data collected by Friends of Fourche Creek after major storm events when E. coli counts spike due raw sewage intrusion by direct flows into it. I think an accurate agency reassessment and increased prioritization are overdue and especially worthwhile.
