

NOTICE OF INTERIM AUTHORITY

Elemental Environmental Solutions LLC
Permit No. 1016-AOP-R15 (Pending)

Notice is hereby given under Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-230(e)(1) that the Director of the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317, has granted Elemental Environmental Solutions LLC's request for an interim authority to construct preparatory activities limited to dirt work, subgrade utility installation, pouring concrete for foundations, and piling/pier installation, to a height not to exceed approximately three (3) feet above grade. This interim authority is conditioned upon the facility (1) notifying the Director in writing within thirty (30) days after commencing and completing construction commencement and (2) any extension request being made at least 10 days before the interim authority expiration and addressing the same factors as the original request. These activities will take place at the following site address:

This interim authority is limited to a period of no longer than ninety days (90) from the date granted or until a final permit decision is made on the pending application, whichever comes first. This decision is subject to and contingent upon the right of the public to object to the Director's decision. Any member of the public may object to the Director's decision or request a public hearing within ten (10) business days of the date of this notice. Objections or requests for a public hearing will be accepted if submitted no later than 4:30 pm Central Standard Time on the last day of the comment period. Written objections or a request for a public hearing should be sent to: Division of Environmental Quality, ATTN: Office of Air Quality, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317.

After consideration of any timely written objections, the Director may revoke or modify the conditions of this interim authority within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of this decision for compelling reasons or good cause shown. The Director's revocation or modification of her prior decision becomes a final decision and will be sent to the applicant and those persons who submitted timely objections. If the Director's initial decision is not revoked or modified within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the decision, the decision is deemed final for purposes of appeal.
