

## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY VARIANCE

Consolidated Grain and Barge Co.  
AFIN 18-00881; Permit No. 2215-AR-1

Notice is hereby given under Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-230(e)(1) that the Chief Administrator of the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317, has granted Consolidated Grain and Barge Co.'s request for a temporary variance to operate its truck loadout operation (SN-13) with an increased throughput limit from 1,000,000 bushels (on a 12-month rolling basis) to 1,300,000 bushels (on a 12-month rolling basis) for a period of ninety (90) days. These activities will take place at the following site address:

This temporary variance is limited to ninety (90) days. This decision is subject to and contingent upon the right of the public to object to the Chief Administrator's decision. Any member of the public may object to the Chief Administrator's decision or request a public hearing within ten (10) business days of the date of this notice. Objections or requests for a public hearing will be accepted if submitted no later than 4:30 pm Central Standard Time on the last day of the comment period. Written objections or a request for a public hearing should be sent to: Division of Environmental Quality, ATTN: Office of Air Quality, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317.

After consideration of any timely written objections, the Chief Administrator may revoke or modify the conditions of this temporary variance within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of this decision for compelling reasons or good cause shown. The Chief Administrator's revocation or modification of her prior decision becomes a final decision and will be sent to the applicant and those persons who submitted timely objections. If the Chief Administrator's initial decision is not revoked or modified within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the decision, the decision is deemed final for purposes of appeal.
