**EPA Approves Replacement of Federal Plan with State Plan  
to Address Emissions of Visibility Impairing Pollutants**

**NORTH LITTLE ROCK**—On March 16, 2020, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) proposed to approve a revision to the Arkansas state implementation plan (SIP) and withdraw a federal implementation plan. The SIP revisions that EPA proposes to approve address regional haze rule requirements for Ashdown Mill, a pulp and paper mill owned by Domtar LLC., and Clean Air Act 110 requirements for prevention of interstate transport of visibility impairing pollutants.
