PC&EC to Hold February Meeting via Zoom

NORTH LITTLE ROCK—COVID cases in Arkansas have resulted in the Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment (E&E) and the Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (PC&EC) taking precautions to reduce the spread of COVID. Accordingly, the PC&EC meeting scheduled for Friday, February 25, 2022, will be held via Zoom video conferencing starting at 9 a.m. The February PC&EC meeting agenda includes a request from the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a favorable vote initiating a rulemaking docket for Rule 27, and a request for a PC&EC vote on two Recommended Decisions—In the Matter of Northwest Arkansas Conservation Authority, Docket No. 22-001-P and In the Matter of Springdale Water and Sewer, Docket No. 22-002-P.
