\$7 Million in Funding Available for Fleet Emissions Reduction

NORTH LITTLE ROCK—The Arkansas Department of Energy & Environment (E&E), Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ) intends to award up to \$7,671,688 to applicants who successfully complete proposals submitted to its Advanced Bus and Clean (ABC) Transportation Program.

The goal of the ABC Transportation Program, which is funded by the Volkswagen Settlement fund, is to reduce nitrogen oxides emissions from Arkansas fleets and to encourage the development of alternative fuels infrastructure within the state.

Applications must be submitted via ePortal at <u>https://eportal.adeq.state.ar.us/?FormTag=ABC_App</u> from May 1 through June 30, 2022.
