## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

## Waste Management Eco-Vista, LLC Class 1 and Class 4 LandfillExisting Permit Numbers: 0290-S1-R3 and 0290-S4-R1AFIN: 72-00144

The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), under provisions of Regulation No. 22 of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission, has scheduled a Public Meeting in at The Jones Center on September 4, 2018 to discuss the proposed lateral expansion of the Eco-Vista Class 1Landfill and Class 4 Landfill located in Tontitown, Arkansas. The scheduled Public Meeting will be held in the The Jones Center, 922 East Emma Avenue, Springdale, AR 72764. The Public Meeting is scheduled to begin at 6-8pm.

The ADEQ Office of Land Resources has determined Eco-Vista has submitted an administratively complete Pre-Application requesting to construct a lateral expansion that includes an increase both acreage and capacity at the Eco-Vista Class 1 landfill and Class 4 Landfill. The Class 1 Landfill would accept nonhazardous household, commercial, and industrial solid waste as defined by Regulation No. 22; and other special wastes as defined by APC&EC Regulation No. 22. The current Pre-Application contemplates a Class 1 approximate increase of 10 acres and increase in capacity, and a Class 4 approximate increase of 12 acres and increase in capacity. These increases are considered a major modification and a lateral expansion. The proposed expansion of the Class 1 Landfill is located north and east of a closed Class 1 landfill on site and to the south and west of the existing Class 1 landfill. The proposed expansion on the Class 4 Landfill is adjacent to the north of the current Class 4 Landfill. The proposed Eco-Vista Class 1 Landfill and Class 4 Landfill are located at 2210 Waste Management Drive, Springdale, Arkansas. The proposed facility is located southwest of Tontitown, Arkansas adjacent to and south of Washington County Road 52. The proposed expansion is generally located in the South 1/2 of Section 14 and the North 1/2 of Section 23, Township 17 North, Range 31 West, in Washington County, Arkansas.

The purpose of the Public Meeting is to provide interested persons with the opportunity to meet with ADEQ SWMD staff and informally discuss the agency's solid waste permitting process, as well as discuss the proposed Eco-Vista Class 1 Landfill and Class 4 Landfill. Since the meeting is not a formal hearing, no prepared statements are necessary, and no record of the proceedings will be made.
