The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) reviewed the RCRA Part A and Part B Renewal Permit Application submitted by Beazers/Koppers on November 7, 2016, revised January 25, 2017 to ensure compliance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Regulation No. 23. ADEQ proposes to issue a Renewal Permit (hereinafter Permit 24H-RN2) to Beazers/Koppers for the RCRA Post-Closure care of two (2) Hazardous Waste Landfills and U.S. Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Corrective Action.

ADEQ will make a final decision on the Renewal Permit Application request after the public comment period. ADEQ will, in response to written requests, hold a public hearing whenever the ADEQ Director determines such a hearing might clarify issues concerning the proposed Renewal Permit issuance. Any request for a hearing must include the requestor's name and address and shall state the nature of the issues to be raised in a hearing. ADEQ will issue a public notice of a hearing at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing.

ADEQ maintains a list of interested individuals who are mailed copies of a Fact Sheet on or near the day of publication of a public notice relating to these proposed actions.

Any individuals, including the Applicant, who wish to comment, request a public hearing or add their names to the mailing list concerning ADEQ decisions relating to the Renewal Permit Application, must do so by hand delivering or mailing written comments, along with their name and mailing address to:
