On April 11, 2017, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 3 Permit Modification from Aerojet Rocketdyne, Inc. Aerojet Rocketdyne, Inc. is located in East Camden in Calhoun County, Arkansas.

ADEQ has now determined the RCRA Class 3 Permit Modification, dated April 7, 2017 is administrative complete. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business no later than May 4, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. Central Time. If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
