

**NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE RCRA RENEWAL PERMIT

On March 3, 2017 (revised May 1, 2017), the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part A and Part B Renewal Permit Application from Armtec Countermeasures. Armtec is located in East Camden in Ouachita County, Arkansas.

ADEQ's Office of Land Resources has now determined the RCRA Part A and Part B Renewal Permit Application dated March 3, 2017 (revised May 1, 2017) is administrative complete. Any future RCRA permitting decision that ADEQ makes will be under the authority of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 et seq.), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA), as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, et seq.).

This notice of an administrative completeness determination of the RCRA Renewal Part A and Part B Permit Application satisfies the requirements of A.C.A. §8-4-2003(b). The RCRA Part A and Part B Renewal Permit Application specifically involves the continued use of current RCRA permitted Hazardous Waste Management (HWM) units designed to treat and store hazardous waste.

Persons may review the RCRA Permit and the administrative record at the ADEQ Records Management Section located at 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas. In addition, persons may also review the proposed Renewal Application and the administrative record for this Application at the Public Library of Camden Ouachita County, located at 120 Harrison Avenue S.W., in Camden, AR.

Persons wishing to comment or request a public hearing regarding ADEQ's administrative completeness determination must submit a written request within ten (10) business days of the date of publication of this notice. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business no later than June 1, 2017 4:30 p.m. (Central Time). If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the Applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
