On June 20, 2017, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 2 Permit Modification from Reynolds Metal Company. Reynolds Metal Company is located in Arkadelphia in Clark County, Arkansas.

ADEQ has now determined the RCRA Class 2 Permit Modification, dated June 20, 2017 is administrative complete. Any future RCRA permitting decision that ADEQ makes will be under the authority of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 *et seq.*), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA), as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, *et seq.*).

The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business no later than August 2, 2017 at 4:30 PM. If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
