On August 24, 2017, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 3 Permit Modification from Pine Bluff Arkansas. The facility is located in Pine Bluff in Jefferson County, Arkansas.

ADEQ has now determined the RCRA Class 3 Permit Modification, dated August 24, 2017 is administrative complete. Any future RCRA permitting decision that ADEQ makes will be under the authority of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 *et seq.*), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA), as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, *et seq.*).

This notice of an administrative completeness determination of the RCRA Class 3 permit modification satisfies the requirements of A.C.A. §8-4-2003(b). The RCRA Class 3 permit modification includes administrative and informational changes, the return of the Explosive Disposal System (EDS) to an environmental enclosure for future operations, an increase in the EDS Net Explosive Weight, an improvement to the liquid sampling equipment, an operational change in the frequency of replacing the EDS Containment Vessel Grayloc Seal, and a revision to the inspection schedule for the EDS unit and Munitions Storage Unit.

Persons may review the RCRA Permit and the administrative record at the ADEQ Records Management Section located at 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas. In addition, persons may also review the proposed permit modification and the administrative record for this permit modification decision at the Jefferson County Public Library, located at 200 E. 8th Avenue, in Pine Bluff, AR.

Persons wishing to comment or request a public hearing regarding ADEQ's administrative completeness determination must submit a written request within ten (10) business days of the date of publication of this notice. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business, no later than September 26, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. (Central Time). If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
