Notice of Renewal of Permit

Open-Cut Mining General Permit 0002-MN-AG2 for Eligible Operators of Open-Cut Mines Outside of a Stream Channel and Twenty Acres or Less in Size within the State of Arkansas

This is to give notice that the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), Office of Land Resources, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas 72118-5317 at telephone number (501) 682-0809, proposes to renew general permit 0002-MN-AG2 for the operation of a twenty acre or less sized open-cut mine outside of a stream channel, located within the State of Arkansas under the Arkansas Open-Cut Land Reclamation Act. Coverage under this permit authorizes the mining of material from a site up to twenty acres in size outside of a stream channel once the Notice of Intent for coverage has been approved. At a later date, ADEQ will publish a second public notice announcing the draft permit decision to renew the general permit and details on a public hearing to be held concerning the renewal of the general permit. Public notice, comments, and hearings will be conducted in accordance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Regulation 8.209 and 8.210 (Administrative Procedures).
